Brookhurst Community Park (2271 W Crescent Ave, Anaheim, CA 92801) is a public park in West Anaheim, tucked between a neighborhood, a junior high school, and a local shopping center. Local soccer and softball leagues frequently utilize its fields and facilities. It is known for its popular large, unique concrete playground. Graffiti and gang-related activity has been known to occur in this park.

Brookhurst Junior High is a large public school with roughly 1,300 students in attendance, 79% of whom are from low-income, Hispanic families, and about 30% have limited English language skills. Sam Joo is the current Principal, and Jennifer Sasai and Mike Pooley are the current Vice Principals of the “Brookhurst Spartans”.

The park and school are located across from a major freeway entrance and shopping center, which includes a Home Depot, a Starbucks, Carl’s Jr., and several other stores and restaurants.
