Executive Summary

On April 30th, 2016, six North Orange County Cities – Brea, Placentia, La Habra, Fullerton, Buena Park and Anaheim - held a city wide “Serve Day.”

Anaheim had 600+ participants, completing 47 projects (see list of projects on page 2). All “sectors” were involved: City of Anaheim, School Districts, Businesses, Non-Profits, Faith Based Groups, and Service Organizations. There were 2 rally sites: Central Anaheim (Eastside Community Church) and West Anaheim (Magnolia Baptist Church). Many in kind donations were received as well as enough cash donations to pay all event costs and allow forward movement to the **next 2 Service Project Events set for July 23 and September 10 – please watch www.loveanaheim.org** for specific details as well as opportunities to participate..
